### **PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT ON LAND SOUTH OF KIRKLEVINGTON**

We trust that you all have now had an opportunity to view the proposals, albeit lacking in detail, which were on show in the Village Hall on the 3<sup>rd</sup> November and discuss any issues with the Developers. At the Parish Council meeting held on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November, Councillors completed the Developer's questionnaire and stated an emphatic **NO** to any development. There was further discussion at the meeting about the development with a small group of residents and also consideration given to what we need to do to prepare for any Planning application which may be submitted.

An independent Action Group known as Kirklevington Action Group has been in existence for a number of years and has fought against a number of planning applications both in the past and in more recent months. We have a considerable pool of expertise in the village and this may be needed again once it becomes clearer as to what the developers are planning.
