

NEWSLETTER NO. 8 - PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE - OCTOBER 2016

It is timely to bring everyone up to date with the work which has been carried out by the Parish Council and Kirklevington Action Group concerning the proposed housing developments in the Parish.

Land South of Kirklevington (Jomast application)

Following the Planning Committee on September 7^{th} 2016, the Parish Council contacted James Wharton to let him know the outcome of the vote. We asked him to contact the Minister about 'Call In' of this development. Further to this, more information was sent to London for consideration. It was very disappointing to learn on 12^{th} October that this was not to be the case.

As so many people criticised the Planning meeting and particularly the behaviour of Stockton's Senior Officers, it was agreed to submit a formal complaint. This has now been sent to the Local Government Ombudsman for consideration.

Theakston's Application:

This is still being considered by Stockton's Planning Department and further objections can still be made. We have not heard as yet when this application will go before the Planning Committee but we expect this to be in November. Work is ongoing together with the Action Group to look at objections to this development.

Banks proposed development on Knowles Farm land at the top of St Martin's Way:
